

Butler Springs Christian Assembly Packing Guidelines

Whatever your child brings to camp, it is a GREAT idea to label everything with a permanent marker so that lost and found at the end of the week can be easily sorted through.

Please DO NOT send food or drinks with your camper to BSCA it attracts unwanted visitors

Please use discretion in selecting your child's clothing. What BSCA considers "modest clothing" should be worn at all times. Be careful to wear only shirts with church appropriate slogans printed on them.

For girls, modest clothing would NOT include short shorts, slit shorts, or bikini cut pants. Also NOT considered modest are tube tops, see-through tops, or shirts with "spaghetti straps." Shorts should be long enough to reach your child's fingertips when their arms are at their sides. Tops should be able to cover their stomachs at all times.

For boys, modest clothing would NOT include tank tops, tight shirts, or tight shorts. If kids wear baggy pants or shorts, they must be kept "pulled up" so that their undies do not show. Shirts must cover the child's stomach at all times.

Swim Wear

Girls are required to wear modest, one-piece swimming suits. A two-piece suit, regardless of the style or cut, is not allowed. All one piece suits should be modest (no "French-cut" suits please).

Boys are asked to wear boxer style trunks only. No brief style suits are allowed. Boxer style suits should also be modest – no low riders.

Additional Clothing Info

We strongly recommend that everything your child brings to camp is properly labeled. With hundreds of campers here at the same time, our "lost and found" pile quickly accumulates. Also, remember that this is a "camping" experience. Kids will participate in outdoor activities. Bring clothes and shoes that you don't mind getting "trashed" or seeing on someone else next summer.
